2019-20 ROCHESTER AREA STREET BANNER CONTEST

This contest is open to all Rochester area school students in Caston, Rochester, and Tippecanoe Valley schools systems as well as private schools and home schools. Winning banners will be made into street banners which will hang in downtown Rochester from April through October.

Each school may submit <u>up to 3 entries per grade level</u> in their building for judging. Home and private schools will be considered one school group. At least one banner winner will be selected from each school.

Setup & Design Information for Banners

- Banner Design Theme: "BACK HOME IN INDIANA"
- Original designs are to be made on paper sized 7 1/2" wide by 14" long,
- All entries need to be done as a portrait layout design
- Students are encouraged to make **bold**, **colorful images** with no use of wording.
- Encourage your students to color backgrounds.
- Large images with less detail work well when turned into banners.

Each entry should be labeled on the back with the <u>student's name, age, grade, and</u> <u>school. Please use the attached Excel Sheet to record your entries and email the</u> <u>sheet to fwiser@honeywellfoundation.org to submit. Please make sure you've</u> <u>confirmed the spelling of all names.</u>

Awards presentation will be on **April 22nd**, **2020**, **in the Tippecanoe Valley High School auditorium**. Invitations will be sent to the students homes in March. Every student whose work is submitted for judging will be recognized and receive an award at the reception. Winners will receive a print of their artwork.

Deadline/Entry Requirements

• <u>Entries are due on Friday, February 28th.</u> Entries should be in each building's main office by 12 P.M. A member of the execution team will visit the schools in the afternoon to collect the artwork for judging.
